What is Orienteering?

It's all about the map, not the compass!

Orienteering is the sport of navigating in unknown terrain using a detailed map. You can treat it as a competitive sprint or as a stroll in the park.

Orienteering is an ideal family recreation - it gets you out of the house on a regular basis and our events are designed to cater for all ages and abilities.

What do I need to do?

Bring your family and friends on the day between 08:30 and 10:30, bring a few dollars, carry water, wear sensible shoes and sun protection.

Bring a compass if you have one, although compasses are not required for park orienteering.
