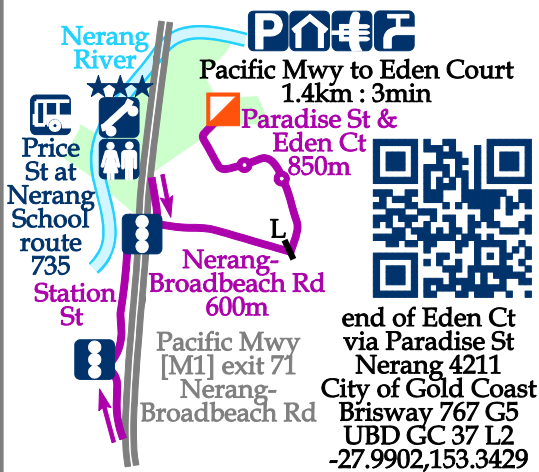

What is Orienteering?

It's all about the map, not the compass! Orienteering is the sport of navigating in unknown terrain using a detailed map. Orienteering is an ideal family recreation - our events are designed to cater for all ages and abilities.

What do I need to do?

Check online before setting off on the day.
Arrive between 08:30 and 10:30; wear sensible shoes and sun protection; bring water and a compass if you have one.
If you are planning to bring a group, please let us know so that we can print extra maps.

This is a low-key introductory event designed for novices and youngsters. It's nothing like that boring compass / pace counting exercise they made you do at school camp!
