What is Orienteering?

It's all about the map, not the compass! Orienteering is the sport of navigating in unknown terrain using a detailed map.

What do I need to do?

Check online before setting off on the day. Arrive between 11:30 and 12:30; wear sturdy shoes; bring water and a compass if you have one. If you are planning to bring a group, please let us know so that we can print extra maps.

This event is generally intended for experienced orienteers. Guidance is available for novices.
