


How to Register and Add Yourself as a State Casual in Eventor (No Membership fees required)

Below are screenshots showing the steps in how a person can register an Eventor account for themselves and then add themselves to the state “casuals QLD”list. If you have other family members, you’ll need to repeat this process for each one, including each child.

Step 1: Select ‘Create Account’

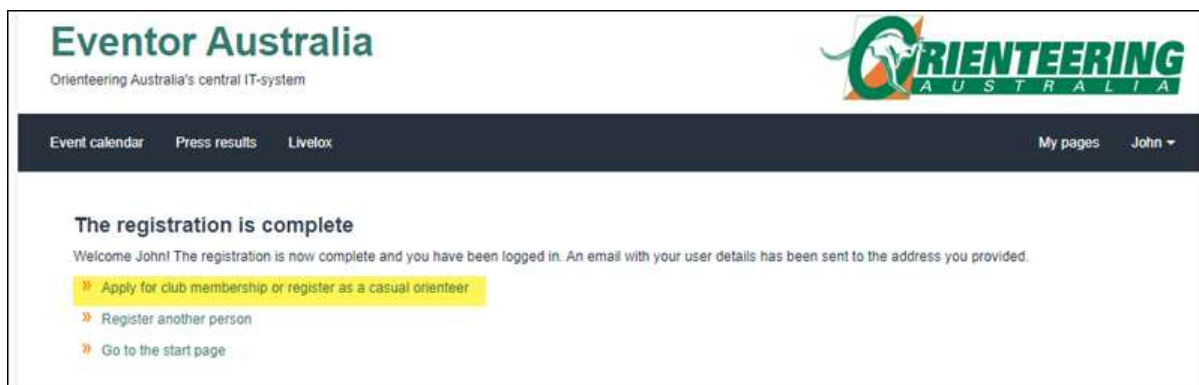

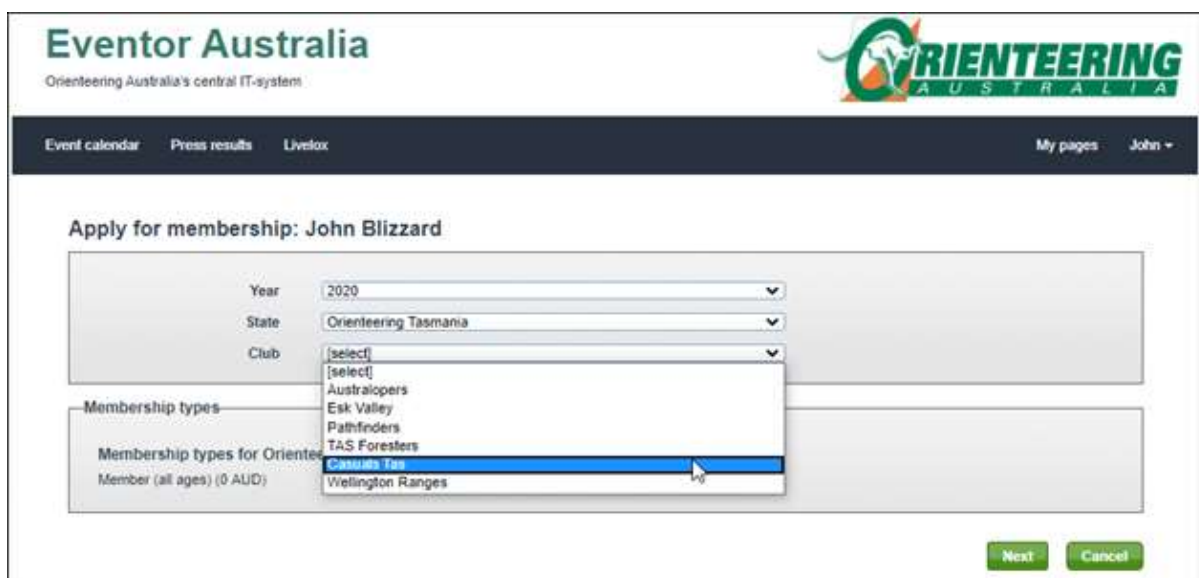

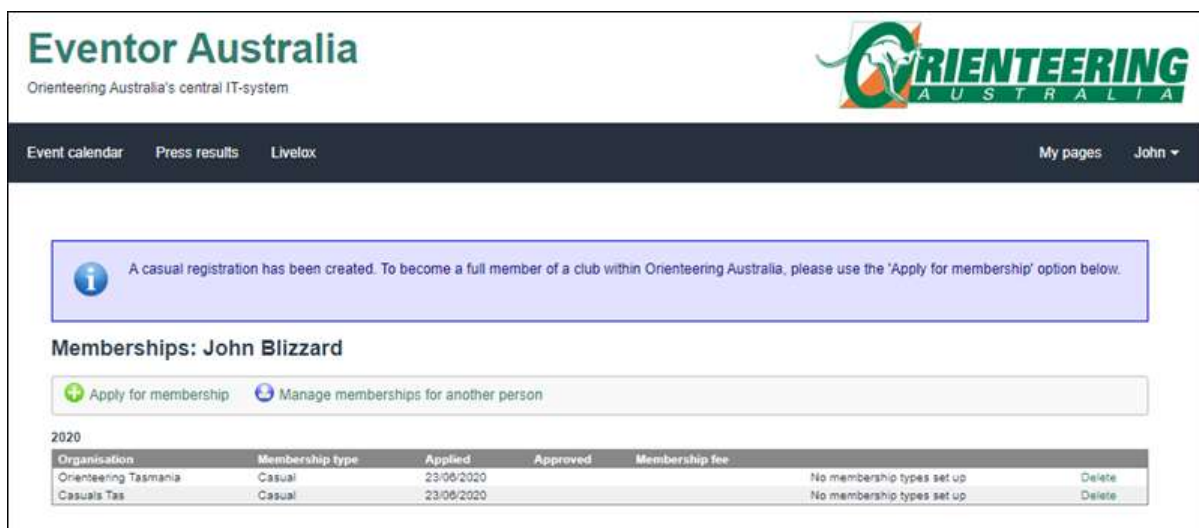
Step 6: Select 'Apply for club membership or register as a casual orienteer'
